- Manage sign language inputs - this will be BSL initially, moving to ASL, GDS (German), LSE (Spanish), LSF (French) and DSGS (Swiss-German). You will not be expected to know these languages but manage relationships with country specialists.

These will be from a variety of sources, web scraping, formal domain-relevant interpretations from Deaf presenters, from the third sector, specialist parties and from large corporates.

- Review and approve translations and annotations.
- Specify and procure a simple supplier management system.
- Engage with automation and latest internal and external R+D wherever possible to ensure processes are rapid and value for money.
- Ensure all suppliers and data gained are GDPR compliant and also compliant with any future privacy legislation.
